We are looking forward to hearing how the Lord has been using the Grasty family!



Missions Spotlight – Wesley and Melina Lane | Dominican Repub.



Wow! How quickly things can change and all of our plans are turned upside down. The Bible tells us in *Proverbs 16:9 "A man's heart deviseth his way: but the LORD directeth his steps."* We can make all the plans we want to, but every now and then we are reminded that we are not really in control nearly as much as we like to think. So, here is what is happening with us right now.

What to do? Just like many churches here, we have gone to online services. We had previously organized our churches in Facebook groups by language and location. So on Sunday morning I preach a service on FB live in Spanish, and then later I preach a second service in Haitian Creole. These services are then re-broadcast on a variety of platforms such as Whatsapp and You tube. Then on Wednesday night the mid-week prayer service is done by Joshua Lane and they are also posting Christian videos for our kids program. I have taken to the internet for "visiting". Last week I personally contacted more than 70 of our Dominicans via personal message and we are continuing to interact with them and with our Haitian Christians as well. We are actually having MORE participation online than we normally do when we are physically present, so God is still in control. But it is a learning process because I am still new to the whole tele-evangelist routine.

We are all safe and well and we pray that all of you are safe and well too. I know that this is a trying time for many churches and many Christians. Stay faithful where you are and so will we, because HE is faithful. Hebrews10:23 Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; <u>(for he is faithful that promised;)</u> Thank you and God bless you.
