All main services air live on Facebook and are then added to our website and Youtube page.

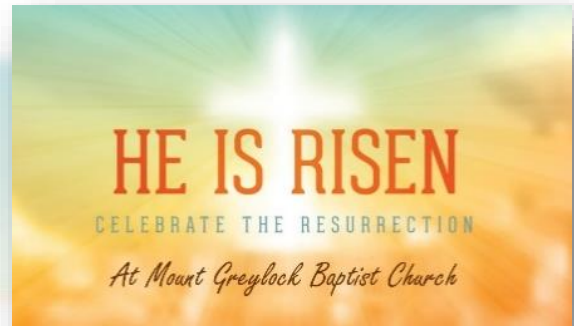

Missions Spotlight – Mike and Lenore Mislán in The Philippines

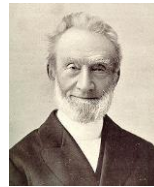


My prostate cancer was diagnosed as aggressive and I can't fly back for needed treatment, my medical plan has not yet reimbursed me for nearly \$3,000 in paid out medical bills; all establishments, many offices and most public transportation have been shut down, we are under a strict 14- day quarantine and can't even throw our trash out till it's over, and expensive cancelled flights, exit clearances, travel permits, van rentals, a hotel and more did not bring us any closer to home, we are living on a cash basis so spent funds tightens our budget.

While we don't know what our future holds, Lenore and I have been serving God for too long to start doubting Him now, and we anticipate returning with many stories of His faithfulness. We appreciate your concerns, support, and prayers, and more specifically - prayers that my cancer will remain at stage one until I start needed treatment in the States.
