Psalm 24



Missions Spotlight - Tom and Cindy Brewer | Brazil

Well, we have been unlocked, but we are still on a short chain! We had our first service on Sunday night, May 3. Seniors, children under 8, and those in the "higher risk" group are not supposed to come to services. Cindy said, "We are already in trouble, because the preacher is old!!!"

Sunday night there were 23 and last night there were 13, present, and then only because some seniors still came and some under 8 still came!

I continue prepare and send out a Bible message every day. Either there are a lot of listeners, or everyone knows how to mark the message as "read"! I am still receiving new phone numbers from some who get the messages, to send out to more people to receive the messages. We Praise the Lord, that even though this is a lot more work, a lot more hours, it is blessed of God work, and it is a blessing to be in the Word and study more and more!

Maybe you have heard that the COVID-19 is still getting worse here in Brazil, but for the time being, the area is still mostly out of the hottest fire! Our town finally had one case, a young man who came home to quarantine with his BIG family, but he brought the virus home with him!

Thus far there are not many close to us who are without work, or without their salary if they are out of work. This town's culture and a lot of this state's culture is already of a "welfare" nature.

We have taken advantage of this downtime to do a lot of maintenance on the buildings and the property. Even though our offerings are down, so are our bills! Many of the members are faithful with their tithes and offerings, and the church is still able to send full support to our missionaries. Most of our missionaries are to Brazilian Indians, and one to Venezuela. All but one have had to leave their works because of the dangers involving contamination of Native Brazilian cultures.
