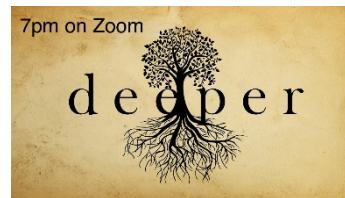

Dear Pastor, Friends and Brethren:

WE'RE BACK! We are happy to report that our second attempt with clearances, passes, permits, check-points and flights have finally brought us home to our sending church where we have survived our second 14-day quarantine, and have gotten settled in.

After inspecting my biopsy slides and the medical records I brought back with me, the initial consensus is that as my prostate and neighboring lymph nodes be removed, followed by radiation therapy. But lab results are still coming in which still have a bearing. I also need some skin cancer removed – so this make take a while. But I'm being treated at a good cancer center, have been jogging and enjoying yard work, and am gaining weight from being well fed.

Thanks to live-streaming, I'm still preaching twice a week in the small church we are helping in Baguio City, Philippines, and have also been teaching a Wednesday night series in my sending church. Lord-willing, like a B-52 bomber being repaired in the hanger, I hope to return to the front lines after being patched-up – where "Seminary Startups" and the small church I am helping are awaiting us.

One good thing that came out of my cancer treatment and this epidemic is that our son Jonathan, our daughter in law Anica, and our grandson Jason, as deputation missionaries are grounded with us at our sending church! So we are enjoying our cherished times with them. Of course we are requesting prayer for my cancer treatments and also that our health plan will cover most my medical bills. I'd also like prayer regarding God's perfect will. While my heart wants to continue serving in the Philippines, I realize we can't keep coming back once a year for various medical needs. So please pray that we can know for certain His plan. We want to thank you for your understanding at this time, especially our sending church who has really came through for us - providing us a furnished place to stay, internet, a vehicle, kitchen, food stocks and more. Yes, even gallons of chocolate milk which they know I love!
