Psalm 145:1-10



Missions Spotlight – Steven and Marilyn Trask | Brazil



Newsletter #253 Year 38 – Special Highlights in the Task

Milestone – April 4th was the 36th anniversary of our arrival in Brazil. Four of us arrived, Marilyn and I and our daughters, Julie and Lisa. Amy, our third daughter was born two years plus afterwards. We are thankful for your prayers and financial support that have helped us to continue in the Task during these years. Thank you so much!

April-May Ministry – Iris Project: Construction – We settled on a roofing company and made the first payment but the coronavirus has made the process move at slow speed. In May, we made a second payment and before the end of May the steel framework and roof material should be in place. New Hope Project: In April we were not able to make headway

with virus quarantine and lack of communication with the new national worker. Mid-May we were able to make a partial labor payment and made a purchase of material to begin the outside restoration of the restart church/congregation. On a visit mid-May saw where someone had entered via a roof segment to steal or attempt to enter to become a squatter on the property. The national worker began to sleep in his car or the property to avoid another squatter invasion. There was another individual who took over an empty land lot next to the building and it appears planned to start a car wash illegally. So local neighborhood superintendent was contacted about this process. Calvary Baptist Church Project: With the coronavirus-19 quarantine there were no new funds received in April. The goal is still \$6,825.00. Mail Service: Still not receiving international mail via our Brazilian postal system. Furlough: Airline company of over 100 years of South America has filed Bankruptcy. The International meeting in Costa Rica was cancelled with the uncertainties of travels worldwide. I am pursuing another American company for my flight via Sao Paulo. Marilyn's flight is not cancelled but the company is not flying in or out of Brazil in April and May. She is to depart before me as I scheduled to leave later because of the Institute semester class I was teaching.
